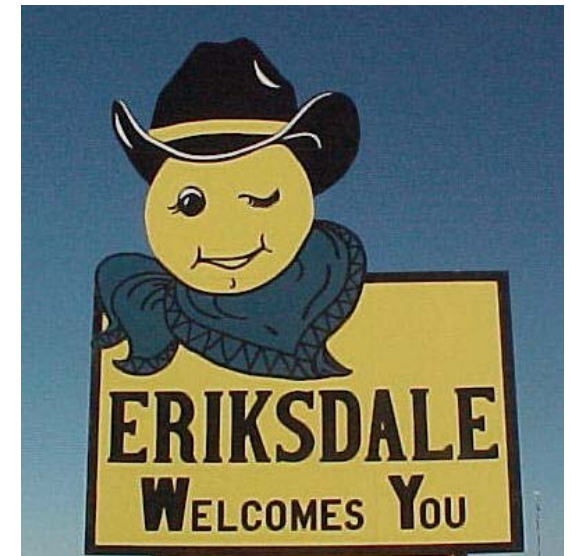

PLACES TO VISIT

Eriksdale Museum Eriksdale Located in the old St. John's Anglican Church on Railway Avenue. Features agricultural and domestic pioneer articles, with souvenirs available. Open mid - May to September daily 1:30-4:30, except Sunday and Thursday. Phone (204) 739-2621.

The Creamery Museum Eriksdale Located on the new street in town. Is the only one of its kind in Manitoba. The creamery is the last small town butter making facility which showcases the functions and equipment of butter making in rural Manitoba. The museum features old creamery artifacts that were actually used when it was an operating creamery.

Moggey's Cabin Eriksdale located 5 miles North of Eriksdale on Moggey's Road. Come and see the famous outlaws cabin at the original site, with walking trails and the recreated cabin of Percy Moggey - a convict turned folk-lore hero. Admission is free. Phone (204) 739-2666.

The Eriksdale Murals Eriksdale Represent a pictorial history of the Eriksdale community. Check out the Murals located on the wall of the Eriksdale Memorial Rink and on the corner of Railway Ave and PTH# 68, painted for the young and the young at heart.
