## Recycling Information For The Coldwell Eriksdale Waste Disposal Grounds

Materials accepted in our recycling program:

**Paper** Newspaper, Books, Phone books, Catalogs, Magazines, Flyers  
**Plastics** Soft drink, Juice, Shampoo, Milk, Salad dressing, Ice cream  
Cont. (Plastic #1,2,4,5,7)  
**Cans** All food and drink cans, tin or aluminium. Pet food cans.  
**Glass** All food and drink containers all colours

Remember these special instructions:

Please make sure all recycling is clean

The quality and cleanliness of the recycling in both Eriksdale and Coldwell is **NOT** getting better, as some people still put garbage and dirty containers in their recycling. REMEMBER our Contractor and his Employees; sort this by hand, would you want to sort through a bag of household waste that has been sent as clean recycling? Approximately 1/3 of the recycling that we process is garbage.

◆◆◆***Plastic Bags and Styrofoam are not recyclable they are garbage***



◆◆◆◆**Dirty recycling is garbage and will not be taken.** ◆◆◆◆

Recyclable products must be in a blue or clear bag no larger than 26" x 36" and weigh less than 50 lbs. You must have recycling in order to have your garbage picked up. You are allowed two bags of garbage; the **bags** can be no larger than **26" x 36"** and **weigh less** than **50 lbs.**

◆◆◆◆◆**Garbage in the big Contractor Bags Will Not be Accepted**◆◆◆◆◆

**Needles and Blades must be in a secure container and placed in  
regular garbage, NOT RECYCLING.**

***The CEWDG Oil Shed takes used oil, filters  
and oil containers for recycling.***

1 ton truck	\$10.00 per load or part thereof
3 ton truck	\$30.00 per load or part thereof
Tandem truck	\$50.00 per load or part thereof
Semi trailer	\$100.00 per load or part thereof
Freezers, refrigerators, Air conditioners	\$25.00
<b><u>If certified "Free of Freon" by a licensed technician.</u></b>	<b>\$5.00</b>
Stove, washer, dryer, dishwasher, furnaces.	\$10.00
