

# RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ERIKSDALE

## BYLAW # 5-2006

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ERIKSDALE TO **AMEND BY-LAW # 2/2002**, WHICH AUTHORIZES AN AGREEMENT WITH THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GRAHAMDALE FOR FIRE PROTECTION.

WHEREAS subsection 260 (1) of the Municipal Act provides as follows:

“Providing services to other municipality: A Municipality that provides a service or other thing within its own boundaries may provide it in or to another municipality with the agreement of the other municipality”

AND WHEREAS Section 266 of the Municipal Act also provides as follows:

“Agreement: For the purpose of providing fire protection services, a municipality may enter into an agreement with a person, another municipality or an agency or department of the Government of Manitoba or the Government of Canada.”

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ERIKSDALE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the R.M. of Eriksdale shall enter into an agreement with the R.M. of Grahamdale to provide fire protection services to the designated area as set out in Schedule “A” to this by-law.
2. That the R.M. of Grahamdale agrees to pay an annual fee and a call out charge as set out in Schedule ”A” to this by-law.
